- A 50% deposit per traveler is required to register. The balance is due by July 1, 2025.
- After July 1, the Historical Society will not be able to refund any unrecoverable expenses.

# Tour Highlights

## Day 1: Monday, August 3

Depart Cedar Falls and head toward **Fargo, North Dakota**. Enjoy lunch on your own en route. Dinner will be included at a favorite Fargo restaurant. Stay the night at **Holiday Inn Express Fargo SW**.

## Day 2: Tuesday, August 4

After breakfast at the hotel, continue toward **Medora, North Dakota**. The first stop of the day will be at the state capital in **Bismarck**. Visit the **North Dakota Heritage Center & State Museum**, which traces the state's rich history from its earliest geologic formation 600 million years ago to today. From a life-size T. Rex skeleton to a 1950s soda shop to rare beadwork, the State Museum offers interesting opportunities for your to connect North Dakota history with your life. Next, enjoy an included lunch at **The Paddle Trap** along the Missouri Riverfront. After lunch, continue on to the hotel where you will spend three nights, **The Hampton Inn & Suites** in Dickinson, near Medora. End the day with dinner at the **Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation**.



## Day 3: Wednesday, August 5

Begin the day with **Gospel Brunch** in Medora, featuring all your brunch favorites while listening to a full band, a gospel quartet, and an inspiring message. After brunch, head to **Theodore Roosevelt National Park**, where you will have a local step on guide. Dinner will be served at **Pitchfork Steak Fondue**, a one-of-a-kind experience where cowboy chefs load New York strip steaks onto pitchforks and dunk them in oil. End the day with the **Medora Musical: The Greatest Show in the West**. This ultimate country western music review is a live outdoor spectacle showcasing a variety of music favorites from Dolly to disco. The show includes live horses and a fireworks finale, all while celebrating Medora, Teddy Roosevelt, and the historic American West.

## Day 4: Thursday, August 6

The day starts with brunch at the **Teddy Roosevelt Show**, featuring renowned impersonator Joe Wiegand. Then head to the brand new **Theodore Roosevelt Presidential Library and Museum**. Opening July 4, 2026, the museum offers 40,000 square feet of exhibit space featuring immersive, digital and interactive displays.

The library aims to provide a complete, honest portrayal of Roosevelt, including his accomplishments and flaws in collaboration with Native American tribes. You will have plenty of time to explore the museum on your own before dinner at the **Brickhouse Grille** in Dickinson.

## Day 5: Friday, August 7

After breakfast at the hotel, it's time to head back east to **St. Cloud, Minnesota**. Enjoy lunch on your own en route, and then enjoy dinner together at **Coyote Moon Grille** before checking into **Holiday Inn Express** for the night.



## Day 6: Saturday, August 8

After a hot breakfast buffet, visit **Munsinger Gardens**. Immerse yourself into a truly unique botanical experience. Located along the Mississippi River, Munsinger and Clemens Gardens feature winding paths to view this dazzling St. Cloud treasure. Enjoy lunch on your own at **Culver's** heading home.
