SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

The Springville-Mapleton Chamber of Commerce promotes educational advancement in the Springville/Mapleton area.

The scholarship is intended for students who demonstrate a genuine commitment to returning to the Springville/Mapleton community following their higher education or training. The scholarship recipients have interest in returning to the Springville/Mapleton area to use their academic experiences or training to enhance local businesses and contribute actively to the business community.

Current high school seniors from Springville High School, Maple Mountain High School, Merit Preparatory Academy, or homeschooled students are encouraged to apply. Please feel free to reach out if you need further assistance with this scholarship application, info@springvillemapletonchamber.org.

Scholarship information:

- The Springville-Mapleton Chamber of Commerce offers a one-time scholarship for graduating high school seniors intending to contribute to the local Springville/Mapleton business community upon completion of their advanced education or training.
- Eligible applicants must be residents of Springville or Mapleton or be an employee of or be the child of a Springville-Mapleton Chamber of Commerce member.
- Multiple recipients may be selected, with each scholarship valued at \$1,000 or more.
- The scholarship is intended to support expenses related to further education at a college, university, technical or trade school, or an equivalent institution. Following acceptance of awarded scholarship payment will be made directly to the recipient's chosen educational institution.
- The Scholarship Committee of the Springville-Mapleton Chamber of Commerce will evaluate applications and announce the selected recipients at the respective school's scholarship ceremonies.
- The scholarship may be deferred for up to three years for military service or a religious mission. Unclaimed scholarships will revert to the scholarship fund after three years.
- In the event that the recipient does not accept the scholarship or fails to pursue their education in the specified academic year, the scholarship must be returned to the Chamber for reassignment to an alternate recipient.

Application instructions:

- Completely fill out the application, preferably typed. However, *if typing is not possible printing neatly may be submitted*. Use additional sheets of paper as necessary, but not in lieu of the application. A resume will be accepted but should NOT be submitted in place of the application.
- **The application deadline is 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 25. TWO typed** copies of the entire application need to be submitted to your High School counseling office. *Others may be mailed to Springville-Mapleton Chamber of Commerce office. **Applications submitted after March 25 date cannot be accepted.***
