The packet also includes a calendar of activities. Have fun completing as many activities as you can, and be sure to color in the activities that you complete.

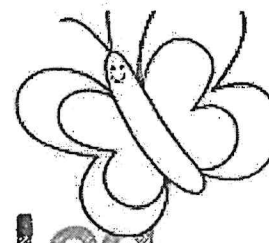
I encourage families to designate a special 'work space' at home for your student to work on their summer packet.
