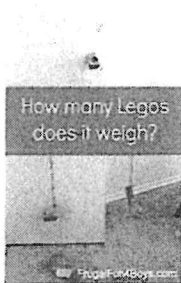
Make a maze using a box top, popsicle sticks, glue, and a marble. Take a picture and bring to school.

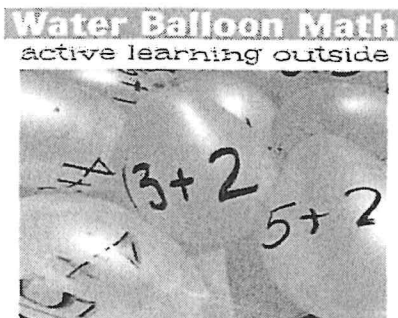
Make a scale. Use a hanger, string, Legos, and objects to weigh. Record how many Legos equal the weight of your objects. Take a picture and bring in your recordings.

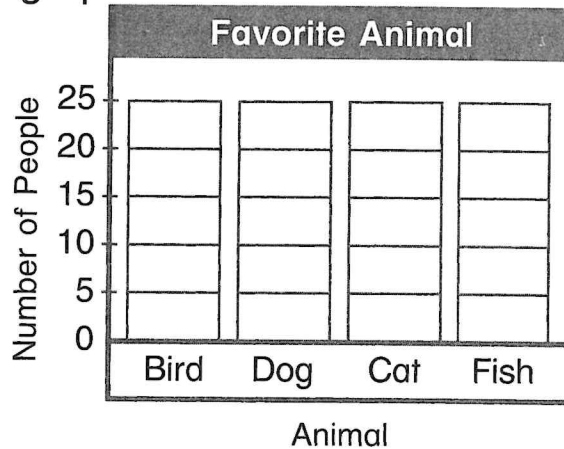
