Activities:

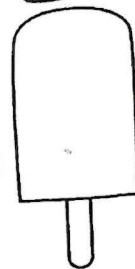
- Practice tracing with the enclosed sheets. If you buy a plastic folder and an Expo marker, the sheets can be used over and over again

Enjoy your summer together building memories!



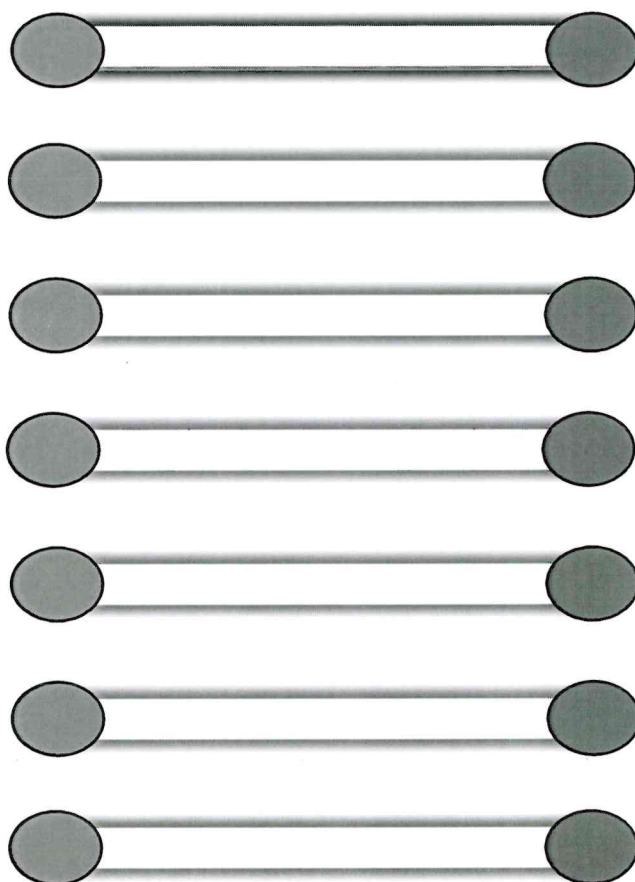
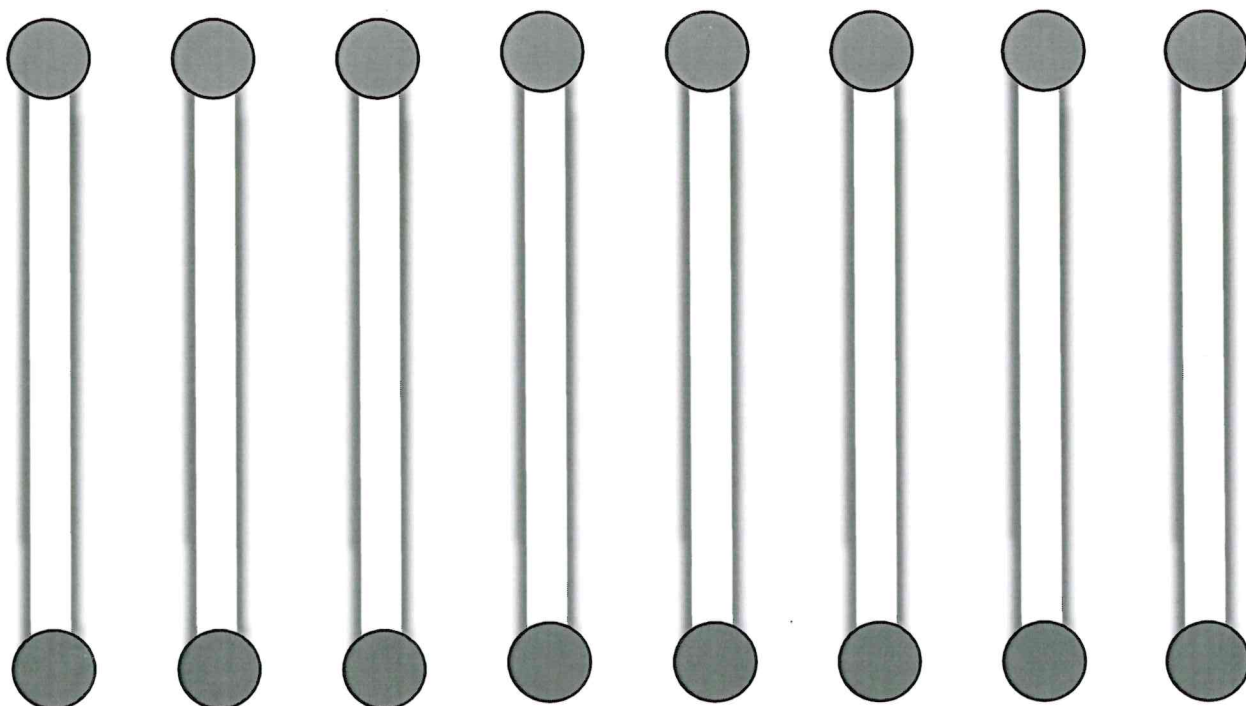

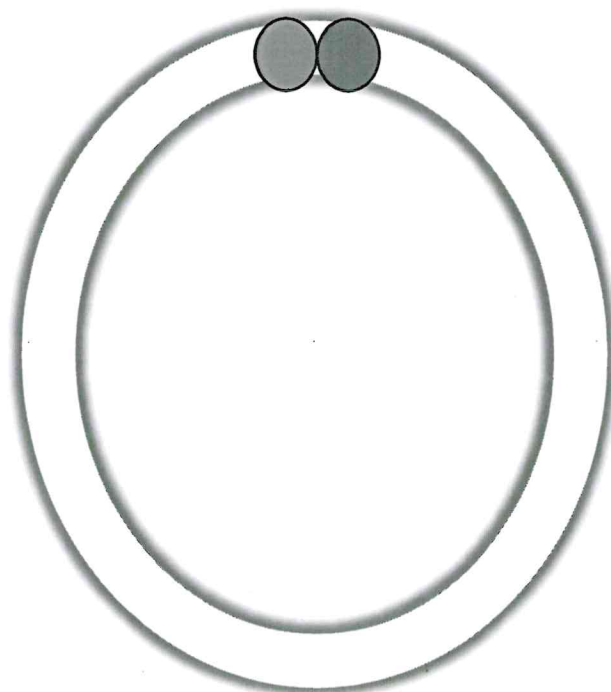
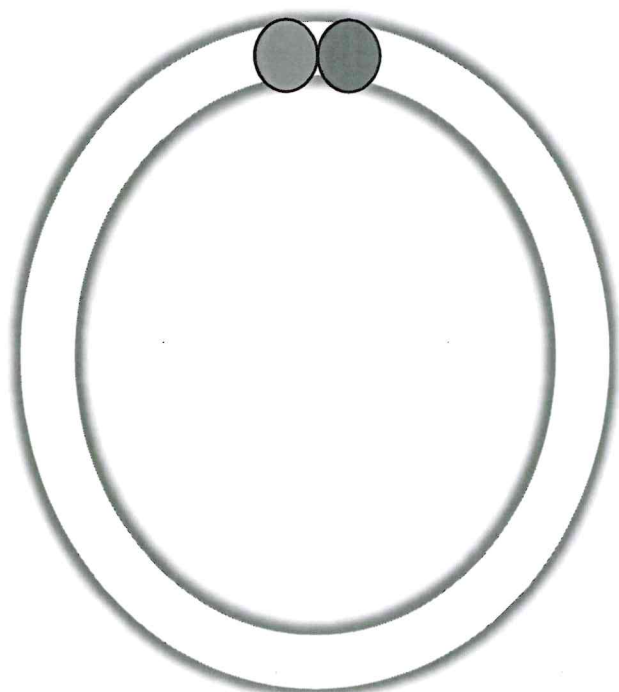
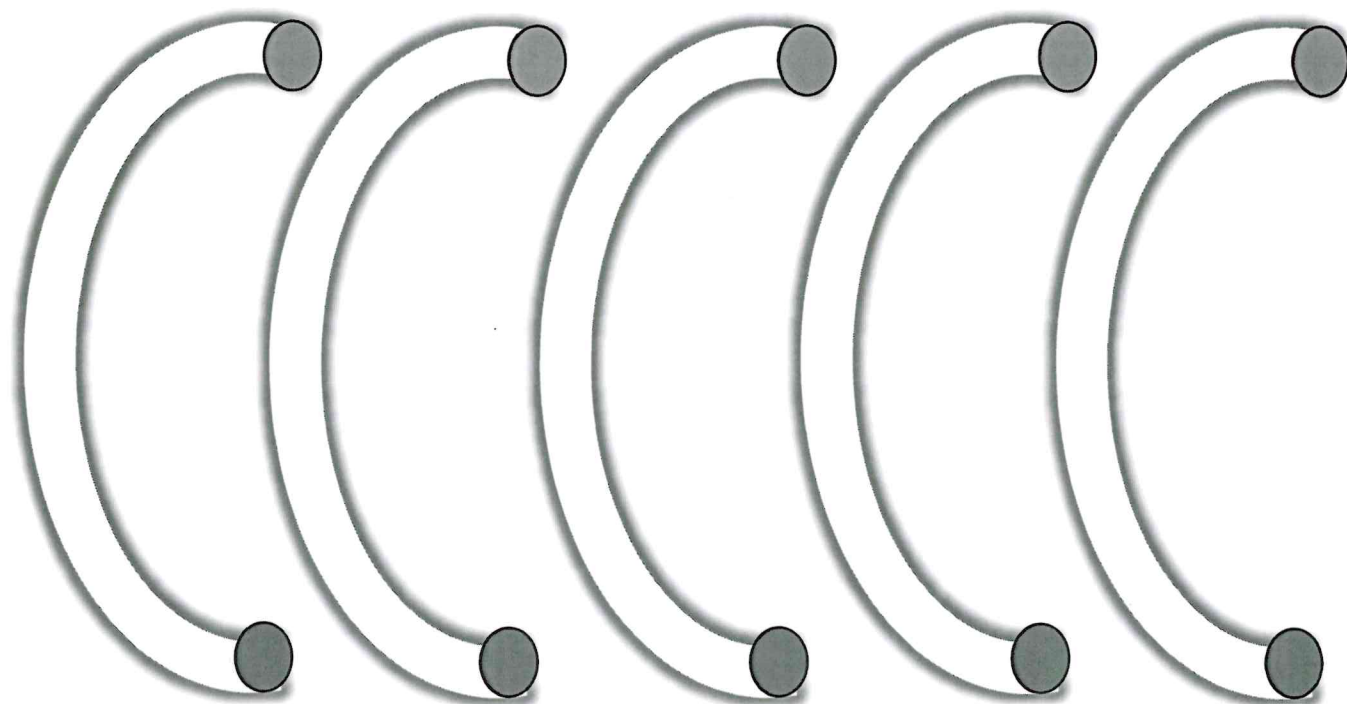
I Can Trace Vertical & Horizontal Lines
