Spelling

Children will be set spelling each week. These need to be practiced at home in preparation for their weekly spelling test on Mondays.

The homework set in Peake class focuses mainly on reading, spelling and times table practice. By the end of year two, children are expected to know their 2, 5 and 10x tables, so it is crucial that children start practising throughout year one and two.

In addition to the above, children should complete one of the following enrichment tasks each week. This will be set on a Friday with the expectation that it is handed in by the following Friday. Children can earn an extra sticker by handing their homework in earlier than Friday. They will also have a treat if their homework is completed on time and if they have read three times at home over the course of the week.

English

English
