Spelling

Children will be set spelling each week. These need to be practiced at home in preparation for their weekly spelling test on Mondays.

The homework set in Peake class focuses mainly on reading, spelling and times table practice. By the end of year two, children are expected to know their 2, 5 and 10x tables, so it is crucial that children start practising throughout year one and two.

In addition to the above, children should complete one the following enrichment tasks each week. This will be set on a Friday with the expectation that it is handed in by the following Friday. Children can earn an extra sticker by handing their homework in earlier than Friday. They will also have a treat if their homework is completed on time and if they have read three times at home over the course of the week.

English- Narrative

What if The Three Little Pigs were visited by Goldilocks instead of the Big Bad Wolf? What would she do to their houses? Use your imagination to write a story about this.

English- Report

Choose one way to help the Earth and write a short report about it. Use a title, subheadings and facts.
Try to use the conjunction 'because' to explain why we need to help.

Maths- Length and Height

Be a length detective! Find 5 items around your house to measure with a ruler and record their lengths in cm.
Challenge: can you find something that is exactly 20cm long?

Maths- Money

Set up a "shop" using 5-10 items from the kitchen and give them a price between 5 and 50p. Choose two items and work out the final cost.
Repeat at least 5 times.

Science

Draw and label the parts of a plant: roots, stem, leaves and flowers.
Write a few sentences to explain the role of each part.

RE

Draw a large pair of glasses. Inside one lens, draw and label something you think is beautiful in the world. In the other lens, draw and label something you would like to fix or make better.

Geography

Create a travel brochure for one of the seven continents: North America, South America, Europe, Africa, Asia, Australia or Antarctica.
Make sure to include: Some of the countries in that continent, information about the climate and an interesting place to visit.

Art

Draw a self-portrait including one animal or object that shows something about your personality.

PE

Have a go at some target games. For example: Skittles, frisbee, football (shooting the ball into a goal), throwing and catching a ball, archery, hoop toss etc.

Computing

Write a set of detailed instructions on how to make a jam sandwich. Remember to be precise.
