Spelling

Children will be set spellings each week. These need to be practised at home in preparation for their weekly spelling test on Mondays.

All children will be expected to read at home at least 3 x weekly, practise spellings, access Tackling Tables to practise and test at least 3 x weekly. Homework will be 'set' on a Friday with the expectation that it is handed in by the following Thursday, children can earn stickers by handing their homework in earlier. Homework should be taking approximately 30 minutes.

In addition to the above, children should complete one of the following enrichment tasks each week with the expectation that all English and Maths tasks will be completed over the half term.

English

Imagine you are Peter Pan and will never grow up. Write an adventure story with 3 paragraphs—beginning, middle and end. Try and include some of the grammar features we have been learning about.

English

Find out about an endangered animal—write a letter to persuade people to save the animal.

Maths

Calculate fractions of amounts. At least 15, use objects to help you solve
e.g $\frac{2}{3}$ of 15
 $\frac{3}{4}$ of 24

Maths

Using a shopping receipt, add together 2 amounts, at least 10 pairs of shopping. Can you calculate the change of items from £10

Science

Grow a seed. You could take picture or record what you spot in a seed diary—you may want to collect information/pics over a few weeks before you hand this in.

History

Find out about the gods and goddesses that the Vikings believed in. Draw a picture of them and create a fact file about them.

Geography

Make a holiday brochure for the South West of England. Remember to include the attractions you have learnt about in your lessons.

Art

Design an illuminated letter for a member of your family.
