

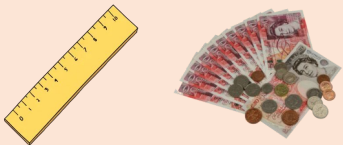
Peake Class Topic Map Summer 1

I hope you have all had a restful Easter break filled with lots of fun. The summer term is a really lovely time of year as the children are really familiar with routines and expectations and their progress academically really shows. Below you will find all the information as to what is happening across this half term in Peake class.

Maths

We are certainly busy in maths this half term!

After finishing up on our multiplication and division unit, we will start a couple of short units on measuring length and height, then statistics. To wrap up the half term, we will begin a unit on money.



English

In English, we will spend some time reviewing KS1 grammar and punctuation and work towards planning and writing our own mixed up fairy tale. We will be inspired by our text: Mixed up fairy tales.



Reading

Once children have mastered reading, they quickly develop better spelling and writing skills and become more independent learners.

We hope you will listen to your child read every night—10 minutes a day is over an hour of reading in a week—and it makes a **significant** difference to your child's success in reading and writing!

SPaG

Children will be sent home with spellings each week, tested on a Monday. Please ensure your child brings their spelling book in on these days.

Spellings are linked to the sound they have been learning in phonics to enable children to use their phonic knowledge when writing the words.

Science

Our next science unit is plants and is a biology unit of work.

Children will learn what plants need and the parts of plants.

Over the course of the unit, children will be exposed to many different types of both deciduous and evergreen plants and trees.

RE

Our RE question this half term is:

What is my view of the world?

Children will spend time exploring what a 'worldview' is and how different people have different views of the world, ending the unit on reflecting on their own worldview.

PE

Our theme for PE this half term is target games and badminton. Our PE days are **Mondays and Wednesdays**.

Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on these days.

Respect, Aspire, Challenge, Succeed

History



Our History learning will be completed in the 2nd half of the summer term.

Geography

Our new geography topic is 'The Seven Continents'. Children will be able to name each of the seven continents, the five oceans and will learn about what the equator is and its impact on the world.

PSHE

We will be learning about personal safety this half term. Children will spend time learning about asking for help, how their actions affect the rights of others to feel safe, bodily autonomy, safe and unsafe secrets, and recognising and reporting abuse.

Computing

Our computing lessons this half term will follow the theme of coding. Children will explore what coding is, the importance of being precise with codes and will begin to code simple algorithms + debugging.

Art

In art this half term, children will look at paintings of children, focussing specifically on the painting of the Graham children by Hogarth. This unit will help children with their observational skills as well as developing their drawing and painting skills.

DT

We need to complete last term's DT (sock puppets) as well as this term's due to the spring term being particularly short. During the course of the summer term, children will make moving vehicles made from cardboard boxes as part of our 'build' topic.
