Spelling

Children will be set spellings each week. These need to be practiced at home in preparation for their weekly spelling test on Mondays.

All children will be expected to read at home at least 3 x weekly, practise spellings, access Tackling Tables to practise and test at least 3 x weekly. Homework will be 'set' on a Friday with the expectation that it is handed in by the following Thursday. Children can earn stickers by handing their homework in earlier!

In addition to the above, children should complete one the following enrichment tasks each week with the expectation that all English and Maths tasks will be completed over the half term.

English

Using your knowledge of adjectives, noun phrases, verbs and adverbs—write a character description of The Iron Man.
(2 paragraphs long)

English

Use your spellings in sentences
(10 sentences)
These need to be extended sentences and start in different ways.

Maths

Draw 6 different shapes—can you split them in half? Can you split them into quarters? Can you split them into thirds? Remember each fraction has to be equal

Maths

Practise column multiplication.
Start with 2-digit by 1-digit and challenge yourself to multiply 2-digit by 3-digit numbers.

Science

Investigate a type of rock. Explain how it was made, the properties it has and what it could be used for.

History

Imagine you are writing a modern day Magna Carta. What rules would you put on there to ensure everyone is fair and respectful?

Geography

Find out about a city in Western Europe. Create a holiday brochure/fact sheet sharing the tourist hotspots, climate information, etc.

Art

Select a local building. Draw it, find out when it was built, who designed it and explain/label the features.

RE

Draw your own symbols to represent the Trinity of God—The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit
