Spelling

Children will be set spellings each week. These need to be practiced at home in preparation for their weekly spelling test on Mondays.

All children will be expected to read at home at least 3 x weekly, practise spellings, access Tackling Tables to practise and test at least 3 x weekly. Homework will be 'set' on a Friday with the expectation that it is handed in by the following . Children can earn stickers by handing their homework in earlier than Thursday.

In addition to the above, children should complete one of the following enrichment tasks each week with the expectation that all English and Maths tasks will be completed over the half term.

English

Write a non-chronological report about architecture/ Architects. Include some of the architects we have learnt about and how they design buildings.

English

Write a setting description based upon the town we read about in The Iron Man.

Maths

Weigh 10 different items - recording their weights in grams or kilograms. Then put them in order from the lightest to the heaviest.

Maths

Practice counting money/giving change with your grown up at home. Ask them to write in your homework book if this was practical.

Science

Explore your toys at home. Do any of them need a push or pull force to work? Describe how they work using the words you have learnt during Science.

History

Draw a 'front cover' for your topic—Wars of the Roses OR complete a 'double page spread' giving us information about what you have learnt.

Geography

Find out about a building/ structure in India or China. Draw it and write down facts about the building/structure.

Art

Design a functional building—think about its appearance and what it needs to be used for. OR build a model of a building using lego/straws/card.

RE

Research and record 5 key facts about the Quakers

Computing

Design a poster to promote Looking after our Planet. Send to Miss Thorne using email on Purple Mash.
