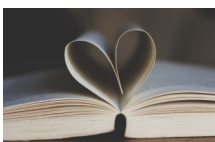
Photos and Slideshow

If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers, clergy honorarium, musician gratuities, and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown as a cash advance on your statement of funeral goods and services.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices, coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. The care and custody of the deceased prior to disposition and staff availability for personal details. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, real estate taxes, heating, lighting and maintenance of building and premises, preparation room equipment, necessary supplies (normal), and transfer equipment (specialized equipment used to handle and move dead human remains). This fee for our services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains. **\$3,000.00**

EMBALMING

FTC: Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
