Performance Highlights



Track

At the end of August there was the last match of the Midland League season at Stourport. It was a day when runners and in particular, sprinters were hampered by strong headwinds. We put out our strongest team this season, with able support from 4 Forest of Dean athletes, scoring 397.5 points. This was our highest total of the season, placing us fourth out the 8 teams. There was a great debut by Nick Borg who took on not one but three tough track events including the feared steeplechase. It was great to see Charlie Exton returning to the team after a 11-year absence. There was a win in the Pole Vault for Zofia Michniok, whilst the individual star of day was thrower Charlotte Colbert who won all three of her throws. The last race of the day was the highlight, with the mixed 4 x 400m team of Claire Borg, Liam Shekyls plus siblings Fred and Eva Tyler outpacing a strong Birchfield team. This result means that we finished 6th in the final league table. A huge thanks to Phil Wells for again managing the senior team and his officials that made this event happen (and scored points for the team)

The last major track event of the season was the County Championships. On a windy and sometimes wet day, this was a success. The smooth running was down to the efforts of the Club committee and many willing volunteers. The big plus of the day was the 100+ PB's by our athletes. A brilliant end to a great season. There were two club records. The first coming from Hugo Benstead in the 75m Hurdles where he broke the 2010 record by 0.3s. The second one came in the U17 Triple Jump. Going into the last round Zofia Michniok had equaled the club record of 9.97m, but Maisie Wood went a little better with her last leap to jump 10.01m to take the record outright. Elsewhere, Rafi Wilkinson travelled to Chelmsford to compete in the English Schools Octathlon Championships. Although Rafi had a slightly under par first day, he rallied well on the second day with 3 PB's to finish 9th out of 34 athletes, scoring 4790 points, breaking his own club record. Marc Flannery competed in the British Masters Championships in Derby, winning the O65's High Jump, clearing 1.45m to go joint 1st in the UK rankings for his age group.

Cross Country/Road Racing/Fell Races

For the first time in many years the club entered several teams in the Midland Counties Road Relay Championships. This achievement was down to the hard work of Maxine Reid who organized the entries. We had two U13 teams of 3 runners each, who came 25th and 27th overall. Of our 6 runners, Jackson Slade ran the quickest leg. The U15 girls team placed 19th out of 39 teams, with Saffi Reid running a very quick leg. The U15 boys were affected by illness and only had Inyan Farrant and Alex Swan running. A fast leg by Fred Tyler ensured the U17 boys were 32nd overall. This team event was enjoyed by all, the 'Green Team' will be back in 2026 – look out!

At the Worcester City Run, Saffi Reid was 4th female in the U16 girls. In the same race Benjamin Swan was the 11th boy home, followed by Harry Jones in 22nd. Logan Lloyd ran in the Men's race coming 41st.

Athlete of the Month - Sept

The committee recognises the achievements of an Athlete each month. This may be a good win, Club Record, a big improvement in a PB, or training hard. This month it is Erin Straker. She is a first year U17 athlete and very young in her year. At age 14 she competed in the three Midland League matches against Senior athletes. She also competed in every Upper YDL match. This time against athletes up 2 years older than her. Across these six fixtures Erin completed 17 individual events, scoring valuable points for the club. Her events have included High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump and Javelin. Erin trains and competes with a smile, always supporting her fellow athletes. This summer she has improved her triple jump by almost a metre and her high jump by 15cms. She finished the season by winning the U17 Javelin at the County Championships. Well done Erin!

As the track season ends, it is time to reflect on what has been a glorious summer of weather and competition. There have been brilliant performances across all age groups, but above all there has been friendship and camaraderie on and off the track. In addition, we have a new tranche of coaches in the process of qualifying to help increase our capacity to support young athletes. The future is looking bright.

It refers to the training and effort put into this time of year, which will mean next Summer you will be a much better athlete.
