**NEW BUSINESS:**

Kenny Jones addressed the council asking if there was anything that they could do about the citizen on Doris Stanley Drive with the flags hanging in his yard with vulgarity and explicit language on them. His concerns are for the children of the city as well as for adults. The Mayor stated that he has sent his Assistant Chief Ricky Simmons to speak with the individual and he refuses to take them down. The Mayor has also addressed the situation with Attorney Brammell and she states that there could possibly be an obscenity clause within an Ordinance but she would have to research those. Another possibility she will look into would be time, place, and manner.

Mayor Gray informed the Council that Councilwoman Aundrea Selter submitted a letter of resignation from the Campbellsburg City Council. He stated that she will be very missed and that we wish her well. Councilman Kevin Collins made a motion to nominate visitor Garold Price. Upon acceptance, Councilman William Brown seconded his motion and was duly carried.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Consideration of a donation to the Meriweather and King Street School Fund Project. Mayor Gray asked for the Council to consider the donation amount. A reminder was given to them of the bid that Mr. Kim Goodloe spoke of at the March meeting in the amount of around \$21,000. Councilman Kevin Collins suggested that they ask the Henry County Historical Society for a grant and Councilwoman Toni Jackson followed up with that maybe we could make our donation contingent upon their grant decision. The Mayor asked that the council continue to think of what they should do and bring those thoughts to the next meeting.

**MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Gray informed the Council that Mr. and Mrs. Suter were in as Grand Marshall's for Campbellsburg Day 2024. He added that we could have more than one if anyone had other suggestions. He also stated that he would like to add the Veterans float back in this year. So far we have 4 food vendors, 10 vendors in the back, 2 in the Community Center, Petting Zoo, and 3 live singers/bands.

Mayor Gray wants to have a Campbellsburg Community "Clean Up" Day. He wants to partner with Rumpke and designate one day for Residents of Campbellsburg only to bring and rid of unwanted items. More details to come.

Lastly, Mayor Gray wanted to report that we are working on Grants for School Resource Officer. We will have to approach the Henry County Board of Education to ask for supplemental income to make accommodations to get this done. The local elementary school has to share the SRO with the other County primary schools and we want to be able to contribute to our cities children's safety.


The motion was made by Councilman Kevin Collins and seconded by Councilman William Brown and duly carried to stand in adjournment at the hour of 7:22 PM.


