**He also reported that properties have began cleanup on Main Street, Doris Stanley and Demo letters have been sent for some on Doris Stanley as well.**


**Tish Mosvold will be the Mayor appointed citizen for the Community Advisory Board once the Fire Department signs and agrees to the contract.**

**Upon further discussion, Councilman Garold Price states that no money should be given to the Fire Department until the Fire Department responds to the contract.**


**Adjournment:**
