CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF MINUTES, RECEIPTS & DISBURSEMENTS FROM JANUARY 17TH, 2025.

**MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Gray informed the council that the salt spreader is destroying the flat bed of the Public Works current truck and it will have to have a liner replaced. This discussion led to the need for an additional/backup truck. He explained that one had been found in great condition at Bachman Chevrolet. It was a 2015 Chevy work truck that they were asking \$21,000 but they had lowered to \$18,000. Mayor Gray had sent Public Works director, William Brown to look at it and it appeared to pass all of the general tests. It needed a paint job and they were taking care of that. Mayor told the council that we have 2 tractors that we could sell one to cover the cost of the truck. Councilman Garold Price made a motion to pay the \$18,000 to Bachman Chevrolet for the purchase of the 2015 Chevy truck and Councilman Kevin Collins seconded his motion. All were in favor.

Mayor Gray reminded the council how he had talked about purchasing the EMS building previously however, we currently own a building on Doris Stanley drive that we could put to better use. Campbellsburg Supermarket has used it since the 1990's for free however, recently Neil Smith has been taking the cardboard bundles and blocking the salt pallets. With the growth that is coming to this city, we have to be preparing and we have the building and we need to use it. Public Works needs a bigger work area to use a lift, etc. At this time, Public Works opens and dumps 60 bags of salt by hand for one load. This building has several bays. One could be used to work on vehicles as needed, one could be used as a hoist, etc. Mayor would like to have the Council's approval before moving forward. Councilman John Suter made a motion to have the Campbellsburg Supermarket remove the remaining cardboard and stop the use of the city building. Councilman Garold Price seconded his motion. All were in favor.



The Council members were pleased with the Report that the Fire Department had presented.

He let everyone know that the Roof repairman had been out and attempted repair but were called to come back to fix again. The main sewer pipe was unclogged and the water heater was to be fixed soon.


**Adjournment:**
