CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at the hour of 7:00 PM by Mayor David Gray. The Mayor led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES, RECEIPTS & DISBURSEMENTS FROM JUNE 2025 MEETINGS

Mayor Gray called for a motion of approval for the 2025 Minutes, Receipts and Disbursements from June 16th, 2025 and Special Meeting Minutes from June 23rd, 2025. A motion was made by Councilwoman Toni Jackson and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to accept as read.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Gray introduced Leanne Yancey with the Henry County Library Board. She along with other members Steve Metcalfe and Tony Jones, began the presentation of a Freestanding Mobile Book Exchange. Library is asking for a location facing North. Once books are reserved, the library brings them and fills it. Mayor Gray suggests that it be placed beside the ice machine near the pavilion and it would be facing north and already has electricity in place. Councilwoman Toni Jackson makes a motion to approve allowing the placement of the Mobile Book Box, Councilman Garold Price seconds the motion. All were in favor.

Mayor Gray introduced Danielle Ashcraft with the Henry Trimble Animal Shelter. Ms. Ashcraft begins by explaining the TNR (Trap, Neuter, Return) Program. The main goal is to reduce cat population. She has gained a partnership with Oldham County Humane Society to neuter/Spay for \$35 per cat. Mayor Gray spoke up to encourage the council to keep a relationship with Animal Control because of the work that Ms. Ashcraft has done for Campbellsburg alone. Councilman John Suter made a motion to donate \$1,000.00 to the Oldham County Humane Society to benefit the TNR program, Councilman Garold Price seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Mayor Gray gave the reading of the Statewide Emergency Management Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement Resolution. A motion was made by Councilwoman Toni Jackson and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to accept as read.

Campbellsburg Cemetery discussion began by the Mayor appointing Councilman John Suter as the acting liason between the cemetery committee and the council members. He also stated that he needed a motion to accept the money received from the Cemetery funds under the previous ownership to open a new account at United Citizens Bank with Kimberly Boyer as Treasurer and Mayor David Gray as authorized signer. Councilwoman Toni Jackson made a motion to approve to accept the funds and open a new account in the Cemetery's name, Councilman Garold Price seconds the motion. All were in favor.


The motion was made by Councilman John Suter and seconded by Councilwoman Toni Jackson and duly carried to stand in adjournment at the hour of 7:34 PM.


