5. Approval of Minutes, Receipts, and Disbursements for February 2026 Meeting:

Mayor Gray called for a motion of approval for the February 16th, 2026 Minutes, Receipts and Disbursements. A motion was made by Councilwoman Toni Jackson and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to accept as read. Motion carried 6/0.

6. Business:

Mayor Gray asked Attorney Chelsey Brammell to have the 2nd reading of Goals and Objectives for the County's Comprehensive Plan update. Mayor Gray asked before reading the Ordinance, if anyone had any suggestions to add from the council and none were noted. A motion was made by Councilwoman Toni Jackson to accept and approve the Goals and Objectives for the County's Comprehensive Plan update provided by Henry County Planning and Zoning. Councilman Kevin Collins seconded her motion and was duly carried. Motion carried 6/0.

Attorney Chelsey Brammell brought the discussion of Compensation increases for City Council members and the Mayor. She explained that there have not been raises in numerous years and gave a comparison to other cities within the county. She also explained that in previous years a Cost of Living (COLA) raise should have been imposed and will continue annually. She proceeded to conduct the 1st reading of An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 2006-03 and 2010-01 and Establishing the Salaries of the Mayor and City Council Members and to Reflect a Cost of Living Adjustment. 1st Reading, no action needed.

7. Mayor's Report:

Nothing to report.

A question was asked about street lights being out and Mayor Gray let the Council know that his staff was working on it. At least 12-15 had been reported to Kentucky Utilities to date. If there are some still out, anyone can call and report the outages.
