CALL TO ORDER

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Gray told the council that two representatives from KIPDA met with himself and Kim Boyer to discuss grant possibilities and the needs for the city. A list of wants and needs were provided and KIPDA as an advocate for the city will write the grants and assist us in obtaining things that we can't afford. A cover for the Train park and blacktopping the gravel lot is one deadline nearing soon. The shade is a much needed addition for the children that play on the playground. It gets so hot and this would help tremendously. Mayor Gray added that the vision he has for the lot would be parking spaces with islands and rounded curbs. In order to start the application, we must conduct a public meeting which is set for June 9th at 7:00. Dustin Duncan with KIPDA will be there to answer questions and take Public suggestions. LIBS will provide a drawing of the project to set up. Secondly, a Resolution must be read. Mayor Gray proceeded to read the Resolution to make application to the Department for Local Government for assistance under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965 and that the City of Campbellsburg hold in reserve fifty percent (50%) of the proposed project costs for the purpose of matching the Land and Water Conservation Fund Assistance. Councilman Garold Price made a motion to accept the Resolution as being read and adopted. Councilman John Suter seconded the motion and was duly carried.




The motion was made by Councilman John Suter and seconded by Councilman Garold Price and duly carried to stand in adjournment at the hour of 7:32 PM.
