5. Approval of Minutes, Receipts, and Disbursements for June 15, 2026 and Special Meeting June 22, 2026:

A motion was made by Councilwoman Toni Jackson to adopt Resolution No. 26-02 pausing the Application and Approval of Data Centers within City Limits and seconded by Councilman John Suter. Motion was duly carried 6/0.
