Mayor Gray stated that roller skate nights have been a huge success. Councilwoman Toni Jackson said that someone had asked her if we would consider having an adult only skate night and the Mayor agreed that they were considering that.

Councilman John Suter asked Mayor Gray how Carrollton Utilities found \$100,000 for the Sewer Project Fund. Mayor Gray explained that once he told Kaleb Nab that he would go to Henry County




Adjournment:
