CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at the hour of 7:03 PM by Mayor David Gray. The Mayor led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES, RECEIPTS & DISBURSEMENTS FROM JUNE 10TH, 2024 AND SPECIAL MEETING ON JUNE 17TH, 2024.

Mayor Gray called for a motion of approval for the June 10th, 2024 Meeting Minutes, Receipts and Disbursements as well as the minutes for the Special Meeting held on June 17th 2024. A motion was made by Councilman John Suter and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to accept as read.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Gray began by introducing the Mayor of Carrollton, Rob Adams and handed the floor over to him. Mayor Adams gave a brief background of his family, work, and career milestones. He explained that he will be running for the State Representative seat on the Democratic ticket and would love to talk with folks personally anytime on his beliefs and his interests for the city.

Mayor Gray let the Council know that he was approached by the Campbellsburg Cemetery Committee and they want to hand over the entire program and responsibilities to the City of Campbellsburg. He explained that those members were all ready to retire and pass the torch on to the staff of the City. Public Works and Mayor will take care of the grounds, Community Center Director will handle the calls and plotting of burials, and City Clerk will manage the money and balance the accounts. Mayor Gray would like to get funding for a Pavilion to improve the beautification and functionality of the cemetery. All agreed.

Mayor Gray asked the Council to donate \$500 to the Animal Control Shelter. The Director, Danielle Ashcraft, has gone above and beyond her duties to provide service to this community in her short time with the County. The shelter needs fencing for the animals to be able to run. Councilman John Suter recommends that the City gives \$1,000 to the Henry County Fiscal Court to benefit line item Animal Control. Councilman Garold Price seconded the motion and duly accepted.

OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Gray announced that he and Councilman John Suter met with Fire Chief David Noe. He was supposed to get back with the Mayor and did not. This discussion will be tabled at this time.

MAYOR'S REPORT



Carrollton Mayor Rob Adams inserted that they no longer have a K9 unit and they, upon approval of their council, have a kennel that they would donate to the city.

Dumpster day will take place in September 2024. Mayor Gray spoke with Jeremy Rumpke. Councilman Garold Price asked if they would have to show proof of being a citizen of Campbellsburg. All agreed that YES, this would be for Campbellsburg Citizens only.

Adjournment:


The motion was made by Councilman Mike Ochsner and seconded by Councilman Garold Price and duly carried to stand in adjournment at the hour of 7:46 PM.
