CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at the hour of 7:01 PM by Mayor David Gray. The Mayor led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES, RECEIPTS & DISBURSEMENTS FROM APRIL 15TH, 2024 MEETING

Mayor Gray called for a motion of approval for the April 15th, 2024 Meeting Minutes, Receipts and Disbursements. A motion was made by Councilwoman Toni Jackson and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to accept as read.

NEW BUSINESS:

Brad Stewart With Nelson Insurance Group began his presentation by stating that his company had been representing surrounding cities for over 20 years and had previously issued insurance with The City of Campbellsburg before. He handed the council his proposal of Liability, Property and Auto, Workers Comp and the additional Cyber policy which are all currently insured with the Kentucky League of Cities and Jay Hall, Insurance Associates with the exception of the newly proposed Cyber policy. Comparing his quotes with the previous year's premium payment, Nelson Insurance Groups quote is less over \$4,000. Mayor Gray stated that with all that being said he could approve the change himself however, he would like for the council to be informed and have their approval as well.

Mayor Gray informed the Council that the Planning and Zoning Representative for the City, Darlene Taylor has resigned and a replacement need to be appointed. He stated that Terry Rowlette is one and we need another. Councilman Mike Ochsner made a motion to appoint Kayla Batts, Councilman Garold Price seconded the motion and duly carried to accept as read.

After the First Reading of the Resolution for the "Municipal Road Aid Cooperative Program Agreement", Councilwoman Toni Jackson made a motion to accept the Resolution as read. Councilman Kevin Collins seconded the motion and it was duly carried as read.

The Mayor asked for the Council to consider reading the HC Fiscal Court's Ordinance No# 840-03-24-8 Dog Licensing and Animal Ordinance. He explained that the new dog catcher, Danielle Ashcraft, had updated the ordinance and recommended that the City adopt theirs. Attorney Chelsey Brammell suggested to refer to HC's ordinance, particularly the fines. Councilwoman Toni Jackson asked who would get those fines, and she replied that they would remain in the city. Attorney Brammell stated that she would adjust the ordinance to make it the City's and clarify whoever issues the violation gets the fines. She hopes to have this finished within the next couple of meetings.

OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Gray asked if anyone had any suggestions for a donation amount to the Meriweather and King Street School Fund Project. Councilwoman Toni Jackson thinks that we should do something since it is in our city and maybe we could ask for a specific quote like just pay for a roof, etc. Councilmen Mike Ochsner and Kevin Collins disagree when we have neighborhood schools in need also. Councilmen Garold Price and John Suter think that we should do something. Councilman Garold Price suggested

\$500. Mayor Gray asked for a motion to give \$500.00. Motion was made by Councilman Garold Price and seconded by Councilman John Suter and duly carried.

Councilwoman Toni Jackson made a motion to place Jessica Banta as the replacement for Bill Brown on the City Council. Councilman Garold Price seconded the motion. All duly carried.

Mayor Gray informed the Council that the clerk and himself met with Attorney Jake Thompson with Crawford and Baxter, PSC and he will be representing the Code Enforcement Board.



Adjournment:


The motion was made by Councilman Kevin Collins and seconded by Councilman Garold Price and duly carried to stand in adjournment at the hour of 7:49 PM.
