5. **Approval of Minutes, Receipts, and Disbursements for May 2026 Meeting:**

Mayor Gray called for a motion of approval for the May 18th, 2026 Minutes, Receipts and Disbursements. A motion was made by Councilwoman Toni Jackson and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to accept as read. Motion carried 6/0.

6. **Business:**

Mayor Gray asked Attorney Chelsey Brammell to inform the council of its options after the Henry County Planning and Zoning Commission passed the zone change of the property. She reminded the council that they should have received notice of the appeal received from Tish Mosvold. Then she preceded to inform the Council after presenting the first reading of Ordinance 2026-06, An Ordinance of the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky, changing the zoning classification on a tract of land from Agricultural (A-1) to Light Industrial (I-1) on Campbellsburg Road in the City of Campbellsburg. No Action needed.

Options presented:

- 1) Adopt the Findings of Fact and Recommendations of the Planning Commission; or
- 2) Get the record from the Planning Commission and have a hearing with no new evidence provided; or
- 3) Start from scratch and have a whole new hearing.

Several questions were asked because the council did not receive the Findings of Fact and Recommendations of the Planning Commission therefore, it was suggested that they review those and decide before the second reading at the Special Meeting to be held Monday, June 22, 2026.

Attorney Chelsey Brammell proceeded to have the first reading of Ordinance 2026-04, An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No 2025-02 The Annual Budget of the City of Campbellsburg for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026. No action needed.

Attorney Brammell had the first reading of Ordinance 2026-05 Ordinance Adopting the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2026-June 30, 2027.
No action needed.

7. Mayor's Report:

Mayor Gray wanted to let everyone know that for now, Boo Bash 2026 was a go. If the funding were to come through and we are able to move forward with the parking lot and playground project, that may change things but for now we are good.

Driveway Dumpsters installed the port-a-pots at the playground.
