**NEW BUSINESS:**

Mayor Gray introduced visitor Tish Mosvold. Ms. Mosvold asked to be put on the agenda to discuss the effects of Anaerobic Digestion. She handed out her findings of research and explained her concerns of a facility moving within miles of her property and the devastating outcomes that the process has had in other areas in the United States. She stated that she wants everyone to know what could potentially happen. She believes that it is imperative to get a \$5 Million dollar Reclamation Bond.

Mayor Gray handed the floor to Attorney Chelsey Brammell to discuss the change needed by January 1, 2025 in the employee handbook, whether a city employee will be allowed to obtain a medical cannabis card. She explained that neither the Police Department nor those with CDL licenses would be allowed and it would be up to the Council and the Mayor as to the remaining employees. If so, regulations will be implemented for current and new hires. Mayor Gray can implement by Executive Order upon a final decision.

Attorney Brammell proceeded to give the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance 2024-05 An Ordinance Amending Zoning Ordinance No. 2016-05-For the Purpose of Permitting and Regulating Cannabis Business Operations in the City of Campbellsburg, Kentucky.


**Adjournment:**
