CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at the hour of 7:00 PM by Mayor David Gray. The Mayor led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES, RECEIPTS & DISBURSEMENTS FROM SEPTEMBER 16TH, 2024.

Mayor Gray called for a motion of approval for the September 16th, 2024 Meeting Minutes, Receipts and Disbursements. A motion was made by Councilman John Suter and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to accept as read.

MAYOR’S REPORT

Mayor Gray gave a Boo Bash update. We have several vendors and food trucks. There will be games and the time is from 4:00-8:00.

Mayor Gray informed the Council that he has to address the Fire Department. We are getting multiple calls about the Campbellsburg Fire Department and Fire Chief Noe is telling citizens that the City has NOTHING to do with HIS department. Attorney Brammell is trying to determine whether the Campbellsburg Fire Department falls under Chapter 273 or Chapter 75 and should be under the Fiscal Court. If so, there should be a County Magistrate as well as 2 City Council members on the FD board. We have met with Fire Chief Noe and asked for his latest contract with no success. The City has tried to work with the Fire department but they are refusing. At this point, our only option is to cut the allowed funding.


Councilman Garold Price makes a motion to cut the funding. His motion was seconded by Councilman John Suter and duly accepted.


The motion was made by Councilman John Suter and seconded by Councilman Kevin Collins and duly carried to stand in adjournment.
