- Mass is tomorrow, 2nd grade will host.
- Mrs. Vandermeer is having seminarians into our school to "compete" in a contest called "Are you smarter than a Catholic School kid?". Fr Esper will be the judge. This will be held on 4/17 in the school gym.
- The Knights of Columbus will hold the annual Hockey Challenge on Saturday, April 18th.
- 1st Holy Communion will be held on Saturday, April 25th (9:30 and 11:00 Masses).
- Mr R will be involved in an accreditation for St. Isaac Jogue in St Clair Shores and a second one at St Augustine in Richmond. These are always good experiences.

- The school will hold a hearing testing for K, 2, and 4th grades.
- One ask to the PTC, possibly consider investing in new computers for the computer lab as a next big project.

- New blue athletic chairs are getting purchased/replaced to store in gym. One rack done already, will be getting 168 total when finished.

- **Field Day:**

 - Volunteers will be needed
