If you are not awarded with that, please know there is an internal scholarship that Fr. Esper and I review every June. We want to help those in need! Do not be embarrassed or shy. - Tuition Awards are **not given on a first-come, first-served basis**, but we encourage families to apply as early as possible instead of waiting until the deadline. Since several documents need to be uploaded and verified by FACTS, waiting until the last day could delay processing and affect your ability to receive tuition assistance for the upcoming school year.
