Please email your child's teacher with any questions or concerns, or a note inside their folder will do too.

The same applies during **afternoon car line dismissal**. Students are moving quickly to their vehicles, and keeping the line orderly allows our staff to remain focused on supervising students and ensuring they are safely connected with their parents or guardians.

We appreciate everyone remembering these procedures and following them moving forward.

Student safety remains our priority during both arrival and dismissal.

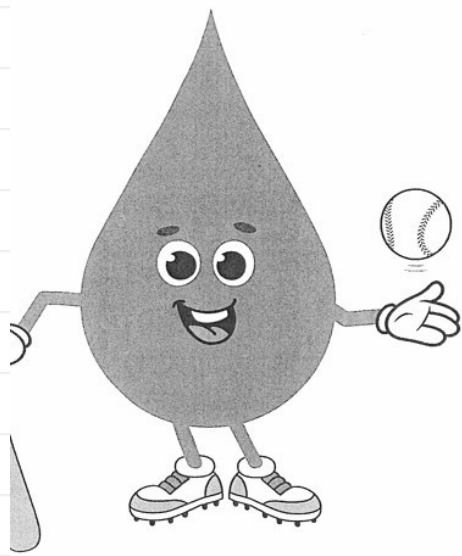
