Gathering & Prelude Announcements - The Life & Work of the Church We Approach God

Acknowledgement of Traditional Territory

We gather this morning on land in Little Current. Before we spoke English on this land, we spoke French and called here Le Petit Courant. Before we spoke French here, we spoke Ojibwe, also known as Anishinaabemowin, and called here Waebijewung. Many names. Many peoples. Many generations. One place. In honour of all who have come before us, may we never forget history didn't begin with English here. There are more sacred stories.

In hope of all the people after us, may we weave our lives with the peoples who call this place home.

We are all sacred people – beloved children of the Holy One.

The wreath is made of evergreen leaves, which "represent the hope of eternal life brought by Jesus Christ".

Lighting the Advent Candle:

Reader 1: Again, we light a candle for hope - hope for ourselves, hope for our beloved world. [light the blue/purple candle that was lit the week before]

Reader 2: Today we remember that Jesus was called the Prince of Peace.

Reader 1: We remember the angels' song: Peace on Earth.

Reader 2: We still do not have peace on earth. Many suffer, because of war and violence.

Reader 1: And so, we light a candle to shine the light of peace: peace in our hearts, peace in our community, peace in the world. [light a blue/ purple candle]

Reader 2: May that gentle and peaceful light spread out all through the world! " (+1)

Come, Peace, come. (+2)


Invocation

> I am walking a path of peace; (3X)lead me home, lead me home.

"People Look East." VU 9 #2

- 1.People, look east. The time is near of the crowning of the year. Make your house fair as you are able, trim the hearth and set the table. People look east and sing today: Love the guest is on the way.
- 2. Furrows, be glad. Though earth is bare, one more seed is planted there: give up your strength the seed to nourish, that in course the flower may flourish. People, look east and sing today: Love the rose is on the way.
- 3. Birds, though you long have ceased to build, guard the nest that must be filled; even the hour when wings are frozen God for fledging time has chosen. People, look east and sing today: Love the bird is on the way.
- 4. Stars, keep watch. When night is dim one more light the bowl shall brim, shining beyond the frosty weather, bright as sun and moon together. People, look east and sing today: Love the star is on the way.
- 5. Angels, announce with shouts of mirth Christ who brings new life to earth. Set every peak and valley humming with the word, the Lord is coming. People, look east and sing today: Love the Lord is on the way.

VU 5 #3. All Earth Is Waiting

- 1.All earth is waiting to see the Promised One, and open furrows await the seed of God. All the world, bound and struggling, seeks true liberty; it cries out for justice and searches for truth.
- **2.**Thus says the prophet to those of Israel, "A virgin mother will bear Emmanuel." One whose name is "God with us," our Saviour shall be, through whom hope will blossom once more within our hearts.
