Threatened Wallum Frog Species in SEQ

SPECIES MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Ergon Energy required the development of a Species Management Program in accordance with State Nature Conservation Act 1992, guidelines to mitigate possible harm that may occur as a result of Ergon activities, including new works, maintenance and emergency call outs. The plan focuses primarily on the conservation of breeding places as required under the Act.





Pentland Bioenergy Project, Pentland

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

\$1.5B proposed Bio-energy Venture on several cattle stations (Milray, Hot Air, Helenslee) near Pentland, FNQ. This project was across 690 km2 This was a comprehensive fauna and flora study including over 100 tertiary level vegetation mapping and BioCondition assessments of Regional Ecosystems and TECs. During the 3 week survey across 690 km2, over 1400 individual vertebrate fauna records were made from over 150 survey sites along with surveying and mapping of 5 MNES species habitats across the study area. The MNES species were koala, squatter pigeon, ornamental snake, black-throated finch and king bluegrass.





Granite Belt Irrigation Project

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STUDY (EIS)

Redleaf completed MNES / MSES flora and fauna surveys of the proposed Emu Swamp Dam and 126 km of irrigation pipeline near Stanthorpe. This included significant residual impact assessments, environmental offsets, protected flora surveys, threatened species surveys and vegetation mapping.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL INVESTIGATIONS

Our team of archaeologists are accomplished negotiators and work closely with our clients to maintain and enhance stakeholder relationships. For example, we worked on a proposed dam project with a budget of \$80M where we worked with several Aboriginal parties, councils, and community stakeholders. We ensured that decisions were made in proportion to the heritage risks on-site and that any proposed impact mitigation works were sustainable for the project.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL DISCOVERY

Archaeological Discovery: Redleaf Cultural Heritage assessed numerous items of local heritage significance and identified scatter locations of historical bottles and bottle fragments, metal pieces and handmade bricks dating from the 19th century to support the identification of state and local heritage significance.





Kangaroo Point, Botanic Gardens Green Bridge Brisbane

ARCHAEOLOGICAL MONITORING

From archaeological monitoring, the evidence of bottles and other period artefacts supports the historical research that the project area appears to have been used as a dump during the development of Kangaroo Point. The date range of the finds, being largely from the early 1900s – 1930s corroborates the historical evidence regarding activity in the area.

Grigor Bridge crossing on the Mary River, Conondale

SPECIES MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR THREATENED SPECIES

Redleaf Group developed a Species Management Program (SMP) for the Mary River Turtle (Elusor macrurus, Endangered) along with fish, platypus and microbats. This included the use of fyke nets, fish traps and turtle traps. Redleaf Environmental also designed and installed bat roosts under the new concrete bridge structure to offset the loss of the old timber bridge.





Greer Bridge Civil Works

FLORA AND FAUNA SURVEYS

Environmental assessment, flora and fauna survey to gain appropriate approvals and permits prior to restoration of the damaged bridge structure and creek bed and banks. This work was undertaken along with 18 other bridge assessments across the Lockyer Valley.





Mountain Bike Trails

EIS INVESTIGATIONS

Redleaf ecologists undertook seasonal flora and fauna surveys throughout the escarpment parks near Toowoomba as part of a proposed 72 km of new trail network. Thirteen (13) conservation significant flora and fauna species were identified to be present within the area of interest during field surveys including of concern and endangered Regional Ecosystems. Based on these finding, there was a re-design of the trail alignment. Detailed designs of trails needed to demonstrate avoidance, minimisation and mitigation of the MSES and MNES values.






