Cookie Policy

Information on cookies and similar technologies | Last updated: 17 July 2026

Current configuration. Based on the information supplied by the Data Controller, this website does not intentionally use analytics, advertising or profiling cookies. It may use technical cookies or similar identifiers required for security, navigation and the operation of the contact form. This position must be checked again whenever the website platform or its integrations change.

1. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files or identifiers that a website may store on, or read from, a user's device. Similar technologies can include local storage, session storage and other technical identifiers. They may be temporary (session cookies) or remain for a defined period (persistent cookies).

2. Categories of cookies

Technical or strictly necessary cookies support functions requested by the user or essential to the secure delivery of the website. They may be used for session management, network security, load balancing, form operation, spam prevention, preference storage and similar basic functions.

Analytics cookies measure visits and usage patterns. Profiling or advertising cookies are used to build profiles, track behaviour across services or show targeted advertising. According to the current configuration communicated by the Controller, these categories are not intentionally activated on this website.

3. Cookies and identifiers currently expected

The exact cookie names and durations are controlled by the technical website platform and may change following platform updates. The Data Controller should periodically verify the live cookie

inventory using browser developer tools or the platform's cookie-management panel.

4. Consent and cookie banner

Strictly necessary technical cookies may be used without prior consent, provided that users receive appropriate information. If non-technical analytics, advertising, profiling or third-party tracking tools are introduced, they must remain disabled until valid consent has been obtained, unless a specific legal exemption applies.

A consent banner is generally not required solely to ask consent for strictly necessary technical cookies. A concise notice or accessible Cookie Policy should nevertheless remain available.

5. Contact form and email

The contact form processes the information entered by the user in order to transmit the request to the studio. This processing is explained in the separate Privacy Policy. The form should include a link to that policy and an unticked acknowledgement such as: "I have read the Privacy Policy."

6. Links to social networks and external websites

The website may contain links to Instagram, Facebook or other external services. A simple link does not normally place the destination service's cookies on the user's device before it is clicked. After the user opens an external service, that service may use cookies under its own policy. Embedded social feeds, videos, maps or widgets may behave differently and should not be added without reviewing this Cookie Policy and, where required, implementing prior consent.

7. How users can manage cookies

Users can delete or block cookies through their browser settings. The available controls vary by browser and device. Blocking strictly necessary technical cookies may prevent the website or contact form from functioning correctly.

8. Changes requiring an update

This Cookie Policy and the website's consent mechanism must be reviewed before introducing services such as:

- Google Analytics or another audience-measurement service;
- Meta Pixel, Google Ads or other advertising/remarketing tools;
- embedded YouTube/Vimeo videos, maps, social feeds or chat widgets;
- newsletter platforms, ecommerce, online payment or booking tools;
- any technology that tracks users across websites or creates profiles.
