


 Prep for Embroidery Appliqué – Same as sewing style, with fusible best choice for secure hold.


SVG or FCM included with design? You're good to go! Does your ScanNCut read PES files? If yes, then Brother or Other machines can access a cut files.


Method #1 – "Coded" PES Design – Remember the Brother thread color for cutting?




Method #3 – Reading PES stitch file
