Double sided means backside of embroidery is hidden & you get a neat finish to your napkins.


Stitch rolled hem from end to end, then "dab" with Fray Check and weave tail under stitches.



Blades & Holders included with 325 DX Model



New kid on the block! Rotary blade for precision cutting. Perfect for fussy fabrics!



More about cutting fabric next month!

Important! When cutting fabric with paper iron on fusible backing (such as Brother CASTBL1 or HeatNbond Lite), best results are as follows:

- Fuse backing to wrong side following directions. Remove paper.
- Cut fabric "face up" on standard tack mat with Auto blade.
- Note, some other fusibles can be cut with paper attached, providing paper does not stick to mat. Other fusibles can be cut without paper if fusible is <u>thoroughly</u> fused to fabric.

- Tips for the Universal Pen Holder:
 - Included instructions call for pens that are at least 70mm long (about 2.75 inches).
 - For best results, choose pens that are the same diameter beginning about an inch from the tip and continuing with the same diameter for approximately 3". Range for pen diameter is 9.6mm (about 3/8") to 11.4mm (about ½").
 - Felt tip pens are recommended.
 - Crayons, pencils, and fountain pens are not recommended.
 - Always set the depth of the pen holder using a sample of the material you want to draw on, then be sure to lock the dial in place once adjusted.
