A MESSAGE FROM OUR LEADERSHIP

Thank you for taking the time to reflect on our 2024 Annual Report. This year marked a true turning point for the Nantucket Boys & Girls Club. It was a time of growth, reinvention, and shared purpose that was fueled by the people who believe in what this Club can do for kids and for our island community.

We are proud to now serve youth at an earlier stage than ever before with the launch of Club Jr., our new preschool program for children ages 2.9 to 5. This expansion reflects a broader vision for the Club: to support the full arc of childhood on Nantucket, from early learning through adolescence. Club Jr. was made possible by thoughtful planning, invested donors, dedicated staff, and the belief from families and supporters who trusted us with this next step.

This year also brought a major investment in our infrastructure with the completion of our sixth unit of employee housing. The new space adds eight much-needed beds for seasonal and program-specific staff. As housing remains one of the greatest challenges on Nantucket, this development ensures we can continue to attract and retain the talented team that makes our programs possible year-round.

Throughout 2024, we launched new initiatives in academics, sports, the arts, and leadership—programs that sparked curiosity and helped kids build confidence, community, and character. From marine science workshops to robotics and civic engagement, these moments were designed with intention and heart.

As always, what we accomplish is only possible because of you. To our volunteers, donors, staff, and partners, thank you. It is an honor to work alongside you and carry this mission forward together. Your support pushes the Club to grow, to adapt, and to dream bigger. Thank you for inspiring us to continue to move forward.

NBGC JR. PRESCHOOL OPENS

In December 2024, the Nantucket Boys & Girls Club opened Club Jr., a dedicated preschool program that marks a meaningful step forward in how we support island families. For nearly 80 years, the Club has served only school-aged youth. Now, we're beginning even earlier by helping young children build a foundation of growth, curiosity, and connection from the very start. Club Jr. offers a safe, nurturing space where children can explore, express themselves, and prepare for kindergarten. Led by experienced educators, the program reflects the same core values that define all our work: safety, belonging, and opportunity.

PARTNER HIGHLIGHT



Thanks to our partnership with Nantucket Dance Theater, NBGC members experienced the joy and discipline of dance all year long.

The program kicked off with our first-ever Child Dance Spotlight, an unforgettable performance to "Shake It Off" at the 2024 Tim Russert Summer Groove.

Thanks to the leadership of founders Michelle Birmingham and Richard William Schaefer, the program grew throughout the school year, supported by Nantucket High School students Greta and Cora.

Together, Greta and Cora led weekly classes for ten young dancers, culminating in a performance at the 11th Annual Nantucket Nutcracker on December 8th. What began in a middle school cafeteria soon moved to a mirrored studio at The Nantucket Hotel, thanks to their generous space donation. The program introduced many of our youngest members to dance for the first time and helped them build confidence, coordination, and joy through movement. We are so thankful to the Nantucket Dance Theater for helping our members shine.

INTRAMURAL SPORTS

JUNIOR CHEFS



POWER HOUR

264 members participated in Power Hour, where they received dedicated **homework help**, one-on-one tutoring, and academic support. The program helped students stay on track in school while building stronger study habits, time management skills, and confidence in the classroom.

TOTAL ECLIPSE



On April 8, 2024, NBGC joined local partners to host a total solar eclipse viewing at Nantucket High School, welcoming over 200 attendees for safe, guided observation. The next one won't be visible until August 2044, when a new generation of Club kids will be ready to watch.

TONY SARG



On August 5, Sarg Community Day at Children's Beach brought Tony Sarg's whimsical world to life through puppet-themed crafts, face painting, a kazoo parade, and a Nanpuppets performance. Earlier in the year, 30 Club members had visited the Whaling Museum to explore the Tony Sarg: Genius at Play exhibition, blending learning and play in a celebration of the island's creative legacy.

EMPLOYEE HOUSING COMPLETE



This year, the Club completed its sixth employee housing unit at 73 Sparks Avenue, a major step forward in addressing one of Nantucket's most urgent challenges.

The new building features two apartments, each with four private bedrooms and en suite bathrooms, designed to provide comfort, privacy, and a strong sense of home for Club staff.





To date, the Club has raised over \$6 million for this effort. Today, 90 percent of full-time staff live in Club-provided housing, which has proven essential in supporting our programs and ensuring continuity of care for our members.

On August 17, 2024, the Nantucket Boys & Girls Club hosted the 22nd Annual Tim Russert Summer Groove, welcoming over 550 guests for an unforgettable evening of celebration and support. Established in 2002 with Tim Russert as its first Master of Ceremonies, the Groove continues to honor his legacy through the Spirit of Hope Award, presented this year to Maureen and John Graf by Maureen Orth and Luke Russert.

The night featured hors d'oeuvres, chef-led stations, a raw bar by Island Kitchen, and a wine lounge by Donelan Family Wines. Club members performed a high-energy dance to Taylor Swift's "Shake It Off," choreographed with Nantucket Dance Theater, earning a well deserved standing ovation.

Remarks from CEO Jamie Foster, Board Chair Matthew MacEachern, and Boys & Girls Clubs of America President Jim Clark highlighted the Club's impact. A short film by Yellow Productions shared the stories of the Williams and Gault families, whose lives have been shaped by the Club.

The evening featured a live auction, paddle raise, late-night bites, and dancing under the stars to the Walton Stout Orchestra. Guests left with Groove hats, candy cups, and full hearts. 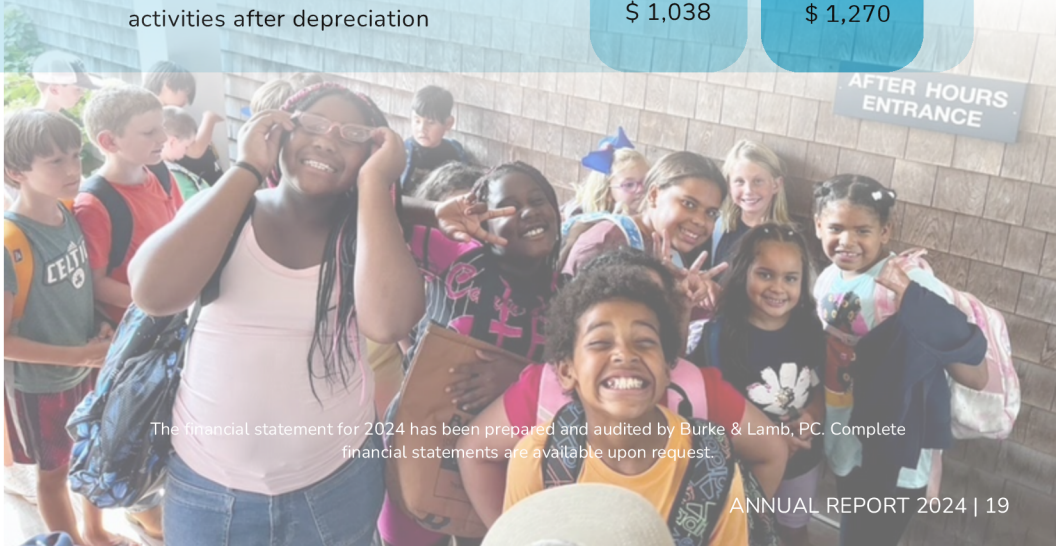

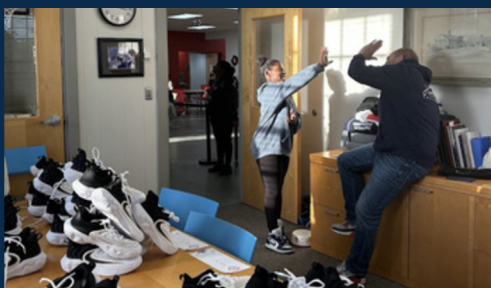
