Dear Church,

Last month we announced a financial gift that will make possible the renovation of the sanctuary restrooms—making them handicap accessible and ADA compliant—and inviting others to give to this project so that we can expand the scope of work to include refreshing the main office and renovating the Media Conference Room and Room 108.

As we announced, \$25,000 more would need to be raised in order to make this expanded scope of work

possible.

To date we have received \$82,900!

This is an astonishing response, and I want you to know how grateful I am to serve such a generous church!

Let this be a case in point: when Boulevard has a need, Boulevard steps up!

Architects were on campus last week taking measurements and finishing designs for the bathrooms, and they are currently securing permits so that our contractor, Mavin Construction, can begin work.

Once we have a confirmed start date, we will announce it immediately.

For now, though, the banner headline is this: thanks to your generosity, *all* of this much needed work will get done—not to mention, we will have sufficient resources in the Capital Improvements fund to begin accomplishing other vital tasks that have been identified by our Building Maintenance Committee.


