Dear Student & Adult Leaders,

The FCA Vision is to see the world transformed by Jesus Christ through the influence of coaches and athletes. The FCA Mission is to lead every coach and athlete into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church. We are so excited to partner with you as we pursue this Vision and Mission.

For FCA Tri-Cities, we are asking that each school Huddle include the following items when planning FCA Huddle meetings and events:

- Share the Gospel at least once per semester. This can be done through a
 guest speaker, video, devotional, personal testimony, THE FOUR, etc...
- Provide a biblically sound explanation, lesson, devotional or video on who God is. (Trinity, One GOD)
- Conduct an activity designed to invite non-believers (i.e. game-night, movie night, bbg, etc.)
- Participate in at least one service project on or off campus. Any activity that allows you to serve on and love others.
- Plan a meeting, activity or event where someone shares their testimony giving God the glory for their conversion (Ideally a student athlete and coach).
- Provide information about FCA sports camps offered locally. This could be a promo video, flyers (provided by FCA), or someone shares a personal experience.
- Create a fun, inviting, and welcoming environments where Jesus can be encountered and experienced.

Huddle Essentials: The 4 W's

WELCOME:

Leaders help establish an environment in which ALL feel WELCOME.

Some ideas of how to welcome people to meetings are as follows:

- Greet at the door with some candy/treats/Gatorade
- Sign-in sheet or name tags
- Music playing
- Bring a friend contest (get a prize or double entry for a drawing)

WARM-UP:

The WARM-UP is a way to get the group to interact and connect at a deeper level.

Some ideas to help set the tone for the group (will vary depending on purpose).

- Ice-breakers/games/questions- go to *tricitieswafca.org* (search Huddle Resources)
- Small Group Olympic Games (competitions spread over month/semester/etc.)
- Minute-to-win-it competitions
- Pinterest- Youth Group Games www.fcaresources.com (search icebreakers)

WORKOUT:

The purpose of the WORKOUT is to encourage spiritual growth. This is the bulk of your meeting and should be a time that is challenging and life-applicable as it relates to sports and faith.

Some examples of workout ideas are as follows:

- Monthly Designated Huddle Purpose (ex. 1st meeting-Bible Study, 2nd meeting serving campus, 3rd meeting-guest speaker, 4th meeting-fellowship/game day)
- Hold a worship service during huddle
- Write cards to coaches during a huddle
- Panel Discussions
- Service/Outreach: Blessing bags for: Soul Soup, UGM, etc. Search FCA Resources/Outreach
- Ideas See www.fcaresources.com for additional resources

WRAP-UP

The purpose of the WRAP-UP is to bring the meeting to a close in a smooth way, as well as being able to offer some sort of "takeaway" or challenge related to the workout.

Some examples of wrap-up ideas are as follows:

- Circle/prayer-take prayer requests
- Play Music as people are leaving.
- Announcements/Flyers/Calendars Instructions:
- Pass out memory verse card challenge
- Clear Takeaway Instructions



GOD LOVES YOU

God made you and loves you! His love is boundless and unconditional. God is real, and He wants you to personally experience His love and discover His purpose of your life through a relationship with Him. Genesis 1:27, John 3:16



SIN SEPARATES YOU

You cannot experience God's love when you ignore Him. People search everywhere for meaning and fulfilment—but not with God. They don't trust God and ignore His ways. The Bible calls this sin. Everyone has sinned. Sin damages your relationships with other people and with God. It keeps us from experiencing the fulfilling life that God intends for us. The result: you are eternally separated from God and the life He planned for you. Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Isaiah 59:2



JESUS RESCUES YOU

Sin does not stop God from loving you. Because of God's great love, He became a human being in Jesus Christ and gave His life for you. At the cross, Jesus took your place and paid the penalty of death that you deserve for your sins. Jesus died, but He rose to life again. Jesus offers you peace with God and a personal relationship with Him. Through faith in Jesus, you can experience God's love daily, discover your purpose and have eternal life after death. 1 Peter 3:18, 1 Corinthians 15:3-8, Romans 5:8



WILL YOU TRUST JESUS?

You can place your trust in Jesus by faith through prayer. Prayer is talking with God. God knows your heart and is not concerned with your words as much as He is with the attitude of your heart.

Here's a suggested prayer:

Dear God, thank you for loving me and wanting the best for my life. I have lived my life for myself and done things my way, and I am truly sorry. Jesus, I believe that you are God and have forgiven all my sins by dying and coming back to life again for me. I trust You and ask You to be Lord of my life. I surrender my life to You. You are my God, my Savior and my Lord. Let me experience Your love and Your good plans for my life! Amen.

PERSONAL TESTIMONIES

A testimony is a story or personal account of a time you encountered God. People who are in a growing relationship with Jesus will have multiple testimonies of what He's done in their lives. Testimonies can include trusting Him for the first time for salvation or one of the many other ways He's changed your life. Writing and sharing your own testimonies is easier than you think. Use this tool to help you share your own testimonies!

BEFORE

Describe your life before you surrendered to Christ:

- Where did I find happiness or security? List specific examples.

DURING

Here are some tips to describe your life as you were surrendering to Christ:

- · What was my first reaction to The Gospel message?
- Why did I finally decide to stop living for myself and surrender to Christ?
- What decision(s) did I make when I turned away from sin and began to live for Christ?

AFTER

Here are some tips to describe your life after you surrendered your life to Christ:

- What are some of the specific changes in my life now? Give examples of those.
- Is my life problem-free now? If not, what is different?
- Reference or provide relevant Scripture examples in your personal testimonies.

1. Audience:

You will be speaking to Middle or High School FCA Club attendees. These students will be from all walks of life, different denominations, and some with no church background whatsoever. Most will have some kind of athletic background or experience, but none is required.

2. Typical Talk Time:

10-15 minutes. Most clubs meet during lunchtime which is 30-40 minutes total, this includes time to arrive, eat, and depart. Please keep this in mind when preparing your talk.

3. Content:

Utilize the current FCA Theme* unless the student(s) asked you to share on a particular topic. See current theme details below. Please use traditional Bible-based content and themes.

4. Prepare 1 or 2 questions for the students to discuss in small groups.

Statement of Faith

- We believe the Bible to be the only inspired, trustworthy and true, without error, Word of God. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

- We believe Jesus Christ is God, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His death that paid for our sin through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension/rising up to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory. (John 1:1; Matthew 1:18,25; Hebrews 4:15; Hebrews 9:15-22; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8; Acts 1:9-11; Hebrews 9:27-28)
- We believe that acceptance of Jesus Christ and the corresponding renewal of the Holy Spirit is the only path to salvation for lost/sinful men and women. (John 3:16; John 5:24; Titus 3:3-7)
- We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, who lives within and guides Christians, so they are enabled to live godly lives. (John 14:15-26; John 16:5-16; Ephesians 1:13-14)
- We believe in eternal life and that through belief in Jesus Christ as the Son of God, we spend eternity with the Lord in Heaven. We believe that in rejecting Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, we receive eternal suffering in hell. (Matthew 25:31-46; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)
