

SPREAD AWARENESS, STOP RESISTANCE

The AMR Tripartite organisations - the **Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations** (FAO), the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) and the **World Health Organization** (WHO) - have announced that the theme of World Antimicrobial Awareness Week (WAAW) 2021 is '**Spread Awareness, Stop Resistance'**. The overarching WAAW slogan continues to be '**Antimicrobials: Handle** with Care'. WAAW is celebrated from **18–24 November** every year.

The WAAW 2021 campaign calls on stakeholders, including policymakers, health care providers, and the general public to recognise that everyone can be an Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) Awareness champion. Participants are encouraged to spread awareness about what AMR is, share stories about its consequences, and demonstrate how the actions of individuals, families, professionals, and communities affect the spread of AMR.
