







Benzathine benzylpenicillin	Bicillin L-A	IM
Benzylpenicillin (penicillin G)	BenPen	IV, IM
Dicloxacillin	Distaph	Oral
Flucloxacillin	Flopen, Flubiclox, Flucil, Staphylex	Oral, IV
Phenoxytmethylpenicillin (penicillin V)	Aspecillin VK, Cilicaine V, Cilicaine VK, LPV	Oral
