







# Oral antibiotics

## A very good place to start

### Start with oral therapy -

Only use intravenous antibiotics when the oral route is NOT suitable



#### Not everyone in hospital needs cannulation

Hospitals can provide safe and comprehensive care while administering antibiotics orally



#### **Oral therapy is often safer**

- Less complications due to cannula
  - pain, phlebitis, bacteraemia
- Less fluid overload for patients with cardiac impairment
- Encourages early mobilisation



#### Always ask—can the antibiotic be given orally?

If the patient is <u>not</u> severely unwell

- Is there an appropriate oral antibiotic?
- Are they eating and drinking?
