#### 1. Apologies for absence

3. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 8th January 2024.

#### 4. Public participation

### 5. Matters arising from previous Minutes

- Wooden kissing gate to Millennium Field. Action: Chairman to organise repair.
- Painting of container on Millennium Field. A working party needs to be organised to prepare and
  paint the container. Boards could then be added to display village artwork. A competition for the
  village can then be advertised.
- Leaning tree by Limes Way. The tree has been removed. It was suggested that a tree be planted to replace the leaning tree, perhaps a lime tree. Action: Cllr Coates to look into the cost of a replacement tree.
- Land by defibrillator at Pond Garden. A resident has moved their fence to claim land that is owned by the PC in this location. Colin Woolford is due to make a site visit.
- **Duck walk past the second bridge in Oxfordshire.** There is a broken plank which needs replacing and there is some fly tipping on the opposite side of the road. **Action:** Clerk to report to Great Haseley PC.
- **Flooding.** Greene King have been in touch with Bucks Council about the flooding by The Old Fisherman as it is affecting trade. Flood awareness signs and height monitoring equipment need to be looked into.
- Play equipment at the Millennium Field. Action: Chairman to source missing caps.
- **Hedge on Mill Road.** This has been cut back.
- Village map for Neighbourhood Plan boundary. Action: Chairman to print off and bring to next meeting.
- Barrier along river on Mill Road. Action: Chairman to discuss with Colin Woolford.
- **Repairs.** The streetlight opposite Limes Way has been fixed. The roadside AED sign has been replaced. With thanks to Sue Maddex the light in the AED secure box is now working.
- Footpath No.7. Action: Cllr Boswell to confirm whether wood chip has been put down.
