### Minutes of Shabbington Parish Council meeting held on Monday 3rd April 2023

#### 1. Apologies for absence.

3. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

#### 4. Public participation

An update was given by Shabbington Nature Network (SNN). An email has been sent to County Councillors regarding the issues we are having with sewage. It was suggested that any new homes cannot be moved into until the sewage system can cope. There will be dawn chorus walk on 6<sup>th</sup> May.

# 5. Matters arising from previous Minutes

- Wooden kissing gate to Millennium Field. Action: Chairman to organise repair.
- Painting of container on Millennium Field. A competition for the design needs to be organised and advertised in the newsletter.
- **Bin at the Millennium Field. Action:** Chairman to send location map for the bin to the Clerk. Clerk to obtain quote from Streetscene.
- Leaning tree by Limes Way. The tree is situated on PC land. Action: Cllr Powell to obtain quotes for the tree to be removed.

# 6. To discuss encroachment of wall / hedge from property on Crendon Road and potential safety risk to road users.

The Chairman has spoken with Colin Woolford at Bucks Council. The encroaching wall will probably need removing, this will be dealt with by Colin Woolford. The encroaching trees and bushes on Marsh Road are causing concern regarding access for emergency vehicles and the refuse lorry.

# 7. To discuss the viability of increasing road surface height by the river Thame near the fisherman pub to enable vehicles to use even in any situation.

Cllr Susan Lewin has met with the local area technician and although it would be technically possible to increase road surface height, it would cost so much that it would not ever be considered a viable project for the County to do. The PC will continue to pursue this idea as it is only a small stretch of road. Cllr Powell reported that he has a meeting with Greg Smith on Thursday regarding the footpath to the A418.
