1. Apologies for absence.

2. Declarations of interest in items on the agenda.

3. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 21st January 2019.

4. Public participation

- A member of the public reported that the Hippo bag in Dukes Close had finally been removed.
- A member of the public reported that the fence down by the river is decaying, a number of fence posts need replacing and brambles need clearing. **Action:** Chairman to put a note in the Shabbington News to organise a date for the work, possibly in May once the weather has improved.

7. Planning

- **19/00623/APP Land between Lulsgate Cottage and Bryers Close, Ickford Road, Shabbington**
The plans were circulated to the meeting. The Vice Chairman had submitted his comments via email prior to the meeting. Following a discussion, Councillors agreed to support the application as long as it is only infill development and not a precursor to possible future development at the rear of the houses. The Parish Council does, however, have concerns about the vehicular access on to a busy road.
- The Rectory Homes planning application on Ickford Road has gone to appeal due to non-determination by AVDC. If the planning application is approved, then land will be available to build the new Village Hut with parking. In the meantime, the Village Hut Committee are moving ahead with an application on the current site.

8. Street lighting & street repairs

The lamps and gear to convert the street lights to LEDs have been ordered with Aylesbury Mains and the work will be scheduled once the stock arrives.

The street light which is out on Crendon Road outside Claremont, opposite The Vines, is still waiting for UK Power Networks to repair the electrical supply box and fuse. **Action:** Clerk to chase UK Power Networks.

9. Millennium Field & Pond Garden

Complete Tree Services have cut back four trees in the Pond Garden.

The rubber safety surface in the play area will be repaired once the weather improves.

10. Meetings

The next LAF meeting is on 12th March 2019 at 7pm in Cuddington.

The Village Hut Committee met on 5th March. They have decided to go ahead and look at the redevelopment of the current site for the new Hut.

The duck boards just past the second bridge after the Old Fisherman are broken. **Action:** Clerk to report to Great Haseley Parish Council for repair.

A litter pick is scheduled for 30th March. Everyone is welcome to help. Please bring litter pickers and hi-vis jackets if you have them.

At least 10 sacks of rubbish have been dumped in the ditch along the road between Shabbington and Long Crendon. **Action:** Clerk to report fly-tipping to AVDC.
