Minutes of Shabbington Parish Council meeting held on Monday 14th July 2025

Attendees

1. Apologies for absence

Cllr Richard Hall (Chairman).

2. Declarations of interest in items on the agenda.

3. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 9th June 2025.

The minutes were approved and agreed as a true record.

4. Public participation

A member of the public expressed concern at the constant barking of dogs from 4 Dukes Close. Cllr Millan explained that there is a litter of puppies living there. A discussion took place about barking dogs in the village. It was explained that this is not a PC issue and needs to be taken up with Bucks Council. The member of the public was told the steps to follow.

Concern was also expressed that the property at 4 Dukes Close is looking messy. The member of the public was advised to contact Fairhive Homes. Cllr Millan agreed to have a chat with the resident of 4 Dukes Close.

5. Matters arising from previous Minutes

- Playground equipment repairs. The Chairman has suggested that we order the parts only from
 Playdale and do the work ourselves. The spinner needs to be disassembled to get it going.
 Action: Cllr Millan to ask for a requote from Playdale to include the spinner. Action: Vice
 Chairman to look at alternative companies to carry out the repair work.
- **Speeding.** It was agreed to leave the 20 is plenty banners up until the end of August and to retension them. A discussion took place around speeding.
- Village Gates. The PC is waiting to hear back from Colin Woolford regarding a site visit.
- **Millenium Field track.** Cllr Davies has sent out a specification for refurbishment at Millennium Field Road. He is currently awaiting the quotes.
- Tessa Alexander's bench. It was suggested that the new bench could be located on Crendon Road, near the noticeboard on the hardstanding where the old bench used to be. Action: Chairman to ask the family about the location of the bench.

6. Shabbington Nature Network Update

There will be a waste talk tomorrow by Bucks Waste Bashers in the Church at 7.30pm.

The monthly water testing of the river has been done. The results still showed high nitrate and phosphate levels.

The annual attack on the Himalayan balsam down by the river has started.

Richard Blandy has asked if SNN could contribute some bat boxes etc for the new Village Hut.

8. Mill Lane and footpath access update

The Vice Chairman met with the Parish Clerk from Great Haseley who is in contact with the Oxfordshire highways team. They walked along Mill Road and observed:

The raised footpath is in need of repair

The undergrowth needs cutting back

The road has deep crevices.

The Great Haseley Clerk will speak to Oxfordshire County Council about these issues.

Action: The Vice Chairman will speak to Colin Woolford about repairing the Shabbington sign and railings where they were hit by a vehicle.

There is a footpath between the 2nd and 3rd bridges which has an inaccessible stile. OCC need to be contacted to request this is replaced by a gate.

- Accounts to end June 2025, as circulated, were agreed. The bank balance stands at £29,681, of which £796 is SNN funds.
