

Earthquake & Emergency Evacuation

In case of an earthquake

- **DROP** to the ground; take **COVER** under a sturdy piece of furniture; and **HOLD ON** until the shaking stops. If there isn't a table or desk near you, cover your face and head with your arms and crouch in an inside corner of the building.
- Stay away from glass, windows, doorways and anything that could fall, such as lighting fixtures or furniture.
- Stay in bed if you are there when the earthquake strikes. Hold on and protect your head with a pillow.
- Stay inside until the shaking stops and it is safe to go outside. Do not exit a building during an earthquake.
- If you are already outdoors, move away from trees and tall structures, including buildings, streetlights, and power lines.
- Prepare for aftershocks. Keep phone lines clear to allow the hotel team to reach you.



Evacuation in case of Tsunami risk

- If you feel a strong earthquake that lasts more than 20 seconds and are instructed by the hotel team to evacuate your villa, please proceed immediately to the indicated Assembly Point.
- Gather only essential belongings (mobile phone, ID, valuables, footwear), do not waste time and be ready to move quickly.
- All evacuations are by foot only. Follow instructions from the hotel team who will direct you to the recommended evacuation route.
