### Case Study - Fast Jet

e-Library was developed to replace existing Technical Libraries with a more robust application which could be utilised across the Resolve user base.

One of the drivers for e-Library was a desire to have a single publication portal for all Airworthiness records published from Resolve, namely General Orders and Special Instructions (2(R)1), Repair Instructions (2(R)5), Special Instructions (Technical) (SI(T)) and Service Modifications (SM), as it was previously published to two disparate systems.

Having the information in two places caused confusion amongst the user base, and the decision was made to move to a sole publication portal with feature enhancements.

e-Library has been successfully used as the technical publication solution since 2018 and is available to all tlmNexus application users.
