- 2. Minutes: The minutes of our last meeting on June 22, 2023 was circulated prior to this meeting. No errors or admissions were stated. ** Motion to approve the Association of Dundas Churches (ADC) minutes of June 22, 2023. (Mary Anne Tangney/Dorothy Bartalos). Carried.

3. Business Arising:

- <u>Cactus Festival</u> (August 17 20, 2023) An Ecumenical Service was held outside at Highland Hills Faith Community (formerly St. Mark's United Church). Good attendance (approx. 176) on a beautiful August Sunday (Aug. 19). The theme was 'Creation & Community". Three 'clowns' handed out promotional leaflets at the Cactus Festival Parade!! (Kudos to the clowns!). <u>Ideas for next year</u> same: Ecumenical Service (people liked worshiping together!). <u>In Parade:</u> Tandem bikes 'working together' as churches! ADC members carrying the huge banner(s) we possess stored at St. Paul's (not necessarily a float every yr!). At the service, some messages written on 'leaves' with the question: 'What would you like ADC to do in/for the Dundas Community?' Responses were:

4. Updated Reports:

- <u>Treasurers Report</u> Peg Turner (Treasurer) reports the Cactus Festival brought in \$775. and the T-shirt costs were \$600. A couple XL are left. The total balance of the ADC Account at BMO is \$1449.95. ** *Motion to approve the Treasurers Report (Peg Turner/Leslie Gerlofs). Carried.*
- Climate Action Team (CAT) Anne Washington reminded us that in June 2023, the CAT Team declared themselves 'on hold' until further direction of the larger ADC Team. Two members (Anne W., Wayne P.) were willing to pursue a 'Community Forum' in collaboration with Dundas Works & Action 13 (local climate groups). Both parties were approached as well as speaker, Linda Lukasik (appointed Climate Action Lead) & are willing to participate. This forum would possibly take place in the Spring, 2024. Focus: 'Where is the City of Hamilton with Its Climate Action Plan' Discussion Does ADC want to move forward with this Community Forum?.** Move that ADC host an event in Dundas in the Spring of 2024 with the purpose of informing the community about Hamilton's Climate Action Plan. (Anne Washington/Leslie Gerlofs). Carried.
- Ministerial Leslie Gerlofs reported that the Ministerial group discussed the 'mission' of ADC & ways to serve our community of Dundas. We need to prioritize and become stronger together. Ministerial felt that ADC could take some direction from the Ecumenical Service 'leaves' (see list above)..enhancing the Monday Night dinners? or changing the way each church handles it's charitable givings when asked for assistance many hand out metro cards, etc. Leslie asked the question: "How do we set people up for success?" ** Possibly our churches coordinate &/or collaborate with our local Dundas Community Services, who know the circumstances of many Dundas Citizens who we also serve. We need to involve our individual churches Outreach people. **(See DCS below). Noted that any changes to the way things are done must be communicated well to the public. This conversation will continue.
- Routes Youth Services Rosemary Horsewood tells us that Routes is up and fully operating with new staffing, after a long on-line presence during the pandemic! The average age is 12 years and the summer brought many new youth. a Youth Resilience worker has been added to staff. The popular babysitting course has returned and is fully booked. October 16 is the annual fundraiser Metal Drive.
- <u>Truth & Reconciliation</u> <u>National Day</u> <u>Sept. 30, 2023</u> Rosemary Horsewood reminded all to wear their 'orange' shirts on Saturday, Sept 30 (this Saturday). Proceeds from Orange shirts go to 'Inspire' to support Indigenous Education.
- O A <u>Blanket Exercise</u> will take place at Highland Hills Faith Community at 9:30 1:00 on Sept. 30, facilitated by Rev. Val Kerr, Retired ArchDeacon for Truth & Reconciliation & Indigenous Matters. All are invited!

- O At this difficult time of high inflation, food insecurity and a crisis of adequate housing (homelessness), both DCS and the Churches are witnessing much greater need in our community and the greater City. <u>Discussion:</u> How do we work closer with the DCS staff? <u>Proposal</u>: Clergy, ADC Representatives & Outreach persons from each church meet with DCS Executive Director, Melanie Barlow for noon lunch & 'conversation' on Thursday, Nov. 2 at St. Paul's United Church (29 Park St. W.). **ACTION:** Norma C. & Mary Anne T. will arrange lunch (numbers from each church will be gathered 2 weeks prior). Invitation will be extended to DCS Exec. Dir. (Mary Anne).
