- **Special consideration:** given to applicants with an immediate family affected by cancer (ie. personal survivor, parent, grandparent or sibling) past or present.
- FAFSA **confirmation** required. Financial need may or may not be considered
- Colleges: 2 or 4 year, public, nonprofit or vocational, must enroll half time
- HS transcript
- 2 Letters of recommendation
- Activities & volunteer chart
- FAFSA EFC document.
- Interviews will be conducted with finalists during April or May and winners presented at JBF Auction & Dinner on June 22, 2024
