2026 Lenten Small Groups


Our Lady of Good Counsel

Lent begins the week of February 15th, and our parish will once again participate in Lenten Small Groups.

This year, we will be studying and reflecting on the small book *A Friendship Like No Other: Experiencing God's Amazing Embrace* by Fr. William A. Barry, S.J.

Books will be distributed by the Small Group Leaders. A printed Reflection Guide will include other study and prayer resources.

This year's Reflection Guide will be offered in two combined formats:



- **for Small Groups** – Since 2013, Lenten Small Groups have been an annual tradition in our parish with as many as 240 registered participants meeting in homes – about 8-10 persons per group.

These Small Groups are a rich way for parishioners to gather with others for spiritual reading, faith sharing, prayer, and strengthening connections with each other.

This Reflection Guide offers the usual outline for the 90-minute Small Group process:

- Part 1: Gathering
- Part 2: Study
- Part 3: Preparing for Sunday Mass
- Part 4: Prayer and Dismissal

- **for Individuals** – Once again, we are offering the option for individuals who are seeking to engage in their own spiritual reading, reflection, journaling, and prayer to make use of this Reflection Guide during their Lenten journey.

The Reflection Guide will suggest adjustments to the outline for Individual use.

Please prayerfully consider how you might be called to share in this enriching experience. Small Groups provide a wonderful opportunity to make connections with others that could last a lifetime. Individual reflection provides opportunities for those who are homebound or prefer that option.

Either format you choose, our parish will be greatly blessed by your participation.


