July Special Collection—Archdiocese for the Military Services

Parishes nationwide will take up the triennial special collection for the Archdiocese for the Military services, USA (AMS), during the month of July. The AMS provides pastoral care to Catholic men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or who work for the federal government beyond U.S. borders - including those from our own parish and archdiocese. The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military, and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment.
